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2017 Summer Enrichment Information and Enrollment Packet

We are planning a fantastic fun-filled summer here at Ashley Academy! Extended care is offered starting the week of May 29 and it will end the final week of August 7th. Six weeks of camp will be intermingled with the extended care events to create an endless array of activities. Review the following pages for more detailed information on both.

Summer Camps *(begins Monday, June 12):*

Summer Enrichment Camps will be offered for six weeks starting on June 12 and ending the week of July 24. Each week a camp for three different age groups will be offered (3-5 years, 6-9 years, & 9-14 years) and a detailed description of each camp is available in this packet. Enrichment camps are Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m., unless otherwise noted.

Extended Care *(begins Tuesday, May 29):*

In addition to summer camps, the summer childcare program will be offered for children enrolled at Ashley Academy, as well as those from the community. The hours of operation are from 7:30 a.m. - 6:00 p.m. The staff has planned special activities and events each week for the children with a guarantee they will not think about school during their attendance. The children will participate in the age-appropriate camps during the six weeks they are offered. For those interested in summer care, please select the column labeled, "Camp & Extended Care" for the preferred weeks. A drop-in rate per hour or half-day is available except for 9 a.m. – 12 p.m. during camp weeks.

Tutoring

Registration:

Complete and return the attached registration form by May 12 to the front office. On the form there are choices for "Extended Care Only" when camp is not offered, "Camp Only", or "Camp and Extended Care." The cost for each option is listed on the registration form. Snacks are included in the amount for all three options. Early registration is recommended due to small class sizes. We will inform you of any changes or cancellations.

Preschool children must be toilet trained to attend camp.

An email will be sent to each family to confirm a child's registration. Ashley Academy reserves the right to make schedule changes if necessary. If you have any additional questions please call 423-929-7888 or email edarnell@ashleyacademy.com or mdosser@ashleyacademy.com

Payment/Refunds:

Tuition payment for camps is due at the time of registration. We accept cash and checks only. If a registration must be cancelled by the parent, a one week notice must be given prior to the start of the selected camp to receive an 80% refund. Otherwise, no refund will be given.

However, if a camp is cancelled due to low enrollment a full refund will be given to each registered participant. Refunds are not given for absences.

Families who are planning to use Extended Care for the summer may request a monthly payment option for this service. Please contact the front office for more information.

Arrival/Departure:

Children in camp will report to the gym between 8:50 a.m. – 9:00 a.m. to meet their teacher.

Campers can arrive at 7:30 a.m. for an additional cost of \$10 an hour, unless registered for Extended Care

Children who are not staying for Extended Care should be picked up at 12:00 p.m. Otherwise, all remaining children will be sent to Extended Care for an hourly fee of \$10 an hour for the first hour. The half-day rate will apply for care that exceeds an hour.

Snack:

Snack will be provided at camp. Please see student information sheet for allergy information.

Lunch:

Children who are staying for Extended Care should bring a lunch from home each day.
