Junior Theater Camp (Week 1: Basics of acting)

The spotlight is calling you! Join Junior Theater Camp to learn the basics of drama through the production of a play.

Week One- We will focus on the basics of acting such as proper stretching, learning the parts of the stage, and projecting the voice. There will be several theater games to practice acting and to tap into the campers' creativity! We will start rehearsals for our play with the assignment of roles. Through the play, campers will learn about stage movement and character development. Max: 10

June 11 -15

Star Camp, A Lego Adventure (Week 1: ages 7-10)

StarCAMP is a unique Lego robotics camp that can take you into outer space. Constructing and programming futuristic robot models is a great introduction to physics and astronomy. To further spark young imaginations, some robots resemble those seen in science fiction movies. Each day campers will work together to assemble and code various mechanisms such as robotic arms and droids. This camp will be out of this world. Max: 10

Junior Theater Camp (Week 2: Prop-making & Costume Design)

Week Two- We will continue to learn basic acting skills and there will be acting games and activities to identify the campers' talents. As we prepare for our show, the campers will learn about prop-making and costume design as we create the set for our show. The campers will learn about stage presence and play blocking. On the last day of camp, we will have a showcase of the campers' production. Max: 10

June 18 -22

Star Camp, A Lego Adventure (Week 2: ages 7-10)

StarCAMP is a unique Lego robotics camp that can take you into outer space. Constructing and programming futuristic robot models is a great introduction to physics and astronomy. To further spark young imaginations, some robots resemble those seen in science fiction movies. This is a continuation of week 1 and campers will continue to add programming elements to the robot models. Max: 10

Camp Invention (Week 1)

Camp Invention is a week in the summer where children are encouraged to explore, imagine, design, and collaborate. Campers will launch into the future and create inventions to solve real-world challenges through these two activities:

- **Optibot** – Children will design the ultimate futuristic vehicle. Campers will design tracks, explore impact sensors using a crash-test dummy and personalize their own robot to take home.
- **Stick To It** - Campers will invent and build their own prototypes to craft solutions to real-world challenges. They will make their own dancing dinosaur, build a plush cupcake catapult, explore chemistry, non-Newtonian fluids and magnetism as they investigate magnetic slime.

July 23 - 27	<p><u>Camp Invention (Week 2)</u></p> <p>Camp Invention is a week in the summer where children are encouraged to explore, imagine, design, and collaborate. Campers will dream up and design their own futuristic smart home while designing and building their own robotic dog. These two activities include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mod My Mini Mansion – Children will take-home mini mansions and explore renewable sources to power. Discover the internet of things and how smart devices are connected and controlled, as well as use binary code to create a message. • Robotic Pet Vet - Children will take apart robotic dogs and compare their inner mechanics to the anatomy and physiology of a real dog. We will analyze simple machines and circuits. Campers will customize their own robotic dog to take home – the perfect pet!
July 30 – August 3	<p><u>Cooking With Math</u></p> <p>Calling all chefs! Cooking camp is recruiting all cooks for our kitchen. Campers will learn basic cooking skills, such as measuring, doubling or halving a recipe, and cleaning up. We'll study math at the same time! We have two new recipes a day that students can take home and easily recreate. We will make many foods such as fruit salad, personal pizzas, cookies and more! Get ready for a week of fun with food!
