



Camps (Ages 9-14)

June 11-15	<p><u>Minecraft</u></p> <p>Whether you're a Newbie who doesn't know a pickaxe from a piston, or an expert who rocks with Redstone, you'll have fun at Minecraft camp! Join us for a week of competitive and cooperative games with your friends, as well as plenty of building, exploring, and fighting monsters as we help each other through the game we all love. June 18 -22	<p><u>Just Dance!</u></p> <p>If you like dancing, then come and get your groove on with a week of rhythm! Techniques, dances, and a variety of music will be explored as boys and girls refine existing dance moves, learn new ones, and create some of their own. Come out to Just Dance and prepare to let all of your energy out!</p> <p><u>Harry Potter World</u></p> <p>Prepare to receive your Hogwarts letter with a week of Harry Potter themed fun! Get sorted into a house, make your own wand, and play everything from board games to Quidditch. Enter the Wizarding World for a week of fun at Harry Potter Camp!</p>
June 25-29	<p><u>Dungeons and Dragons</u></p> <p>Have you ever wanted to explore a fantasy world as a brave knight, crafty trickster, or powerful wizard? Come to D&D camp! Join us for a week- long adventure in a game that allows creative expression and imagination, while also teaching math and problem solving.</p> <p><u>Camp Invention (Week 1)</u></p> <p>Camp Invention is a week in the summer where children are encouraged to explore, imagine, design, and collaborate. Campers will launch into the future and create inventions to solve real-world challenges through these two activities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Optibot – Children will design the ultimate futuristic vehicle. Campers will design tracks, explore impact sensors using a crash-test dummy and personalize their own robot to take home. ● Stick To It - Campers will invent and build their own prototypes to craft solutions to real-world challenges. They will make their own dancing dinosaur, build a plush cupcake catapult, explore chemistry, non-Newtonian fluids and magnetism as they investigate magnetic slime.
July 9-13	<p><u>Medieval Battles</u></p> <p>If you want to be a knight, a Joan of Arc, or just battle with your friends, then this is the camp for you! We will dismiss the conveniences of current days and explore the medieval era with some creative activities while playing some outdoor games with a new twist. Who knew medieval times could be so much fun?!</p>

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July 16-20	<p><u>Nintendo</u></p> <p>Whether you love Pokemon, Mario, Zelda, or more, you will have fun playing with friends at Nintendo camp! Come for a week of games of all kinds on all sorts of different Nintendo platforms such as card games to videos.</p>
July 23-27	<p><u>Lights! Cameras! Action! A Film-Making Adventure!</u></p> <p>Week 1: Week one will focus on learning skills required for pre-production. Students will learn how to write films, set up shots, and begin to use iMovie to edit footage into short films.</p> <p><u>Camp Invention (Week 2)</u></p> <p>Camp Invention is a week in the summer where children are encouraged to explore, imagine, design, and collaborate. Campers will dream up and design their own futuristic smart home while designing and building their own robotic dog. These two activities include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mod My Mini Mansion – Children will take-home mini mansions and explore renewable sources to power. Discover the internet of things and how smart devices are connected and controlled, as well as use binary code to create a message. • Robotic Pet Vet - Children will take apart robotic dogs and compare their inner mechanics to the anatomy and physiology of a real dog. We will analyze simple machines and circuits. Campers will customize their own robotic dog to take home – the perfect pet!
July 30 – August 3	<p><u>Lights! Cameras! Action! A Film-Making Adventure!</u></p> <p>Week 2: Week two will focus on production and post-production. Now that the students have written and planned their films, they will create them. Using iMovie to edit the footage and GarageBand to work with sound, the students will produce short films the whole family will enjoy.</p>

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Extended Care Camps (Ages 3-14)

May 29 – June 1	<u>Nature Week</u> Let's explore Nature! We will create a butterfly and a salad garden; design and utilize a compost bin; take nature walks; find art in nature; and spend a lot of time outdoors. This will be a fun filled week!
June 4 – 8	<u>Who Let The Bugs Out?!</u> Insects and arachnids and annelidas oh my! During this week long camp, we will be investigating 'bugs' that are useful to our environment. We will release butterflies and ladybugs into our gardens; build a worm tower for our gardens; explore spiders and their webs; and create 'bug' related crafts. We'll be bugging out this week!
July 2 – 6 (Closed on July 4)	<u>Water Olympics</u> Come join us for a week full of water-based Olympic sports. We will train for the competition by completing obstacle courses, creating Olympic-based crafts, and racing against each other in timed events. Celebrate victories and bring water clothes because you will need them!
August 6 - 10	<u>"Out of this World" Space Adventure!</u> Planets, asteroids and countless stars are ours to explore as we blast off together for a space adventure. Let's build our own planetarium with constellations, experience how an astronaut eats, and walks in space? We will have an out-of-this-world experience in space!
August 13 -17	<u>Summertime Fun</u> Summer is almost over and school is about to begin. Let's end our time together with a week featuring the best moments in the sun. We will even go on a field trip to see a movie and picnic at a park. Let's celebrate the best summer ever!
